



## Research Grants

The Orangutan Foundation invites grant applications for research into orangutan behaviour and ecology or related rainforest field research in Indonesia. Grants are awarded annually to a **maximum of £500** each. Preference will be given to research focusing on understudied populations and to candidates demonstrating a high level of competence.

### Application Procedure

All applicants must submit the following:

- A completed application form.
- Proposal (maximum of two pages) covering the following subheadings:
  - aims of project
  - methodology
  - anticipated results
  - theoretical and practical implications of research findings
- Budget summary (maximum of one page), including an indication of which items/area of study may already be funded and details of funding bodies.
- Personal statement (maximum of 400 words) outlining your own qualities and the efforts you have made/are making to ensure the research will be completed.
- Two letters of recommendation from academics/professionals relevant to the field of study.

### Conditions of Funding

If applicable, all grant recipients must:

- Show evidence that a valid research permit has been or will be awarded before the grant will be issued.
- Produce an illustrated 'popular' report (1000 words), within one year of the award, for inclusion in the Orangutan Foundation's newsletter.
- Submit a copy of the dissertation/thesis detailing the results of the study to the Orangutan Foundation and, where applicable, to the Indonesian Ministry of Forestry.

### Submissions

**Deadline:** 31<sup>st</sup> August
